DEFINITIONS

PUPPY - Any dog which is not older than 18 months on the day of the test

NOVICE - Any dog which has not won a first, second or third in any Open Test or a first in Novice or any Field Trial award including a CoM, Puppy Test excluded.

OPEN – Open to any dog.

VETERAN – Open to any dog aged 7 or over.

GENERAL : To enter the KC Gundog Working Test, all dogs must be registered with The Kennel Club. Bitches in season will not be allowed on the ground. Anyone knowing their dogs have been in contact with any infectious disease should not attend the Test. Please clear up after your dog and take all of your waste home with you. We are fortunate to be able to use this ground and so please respect it.

Lunch will not be provided for the competitors who should make their own arrangements but tea and cakes will be available for all in the afternoon after the completion of the tests.

A raffle will be held on the day – prizes would be appreciated. We would also welcome any offers of help on the day.
